

In Israel, a melting pot of culture and religion are yours to discover. Visit the cities of Nazareth, Bethlehem and Jerusalem; see the ancient Sycamore Tree and Mount of Temptation in Jericho; enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee; marvel at the Stella Maris Monastery on a hilltop above beautiful Haifa - and more.

This once-in-a-lifetime tour includes return international flights, 13 nights hotel and desert camp accommodation, 26 meals, English-speaking tour leader and guides, and so much more.

## Day 1 New Zealand - Amman, Jordan

Today depart from either Auckland, Christchurch or \*Wellington for Amman, Jordan. Fly with either Emirates, British Airways, Singapore Airlines or Cathay Pacific, plus codeshare partners (subject to availability).

# **Day 2 Welcome to Amman**

Upon arrival you will be welcomed by a representative at the airport and transferred to the hotel.

Overnight: Days Inn Hotel Suites or similar, Amman, Jordan

Meals included: Dinner

# Day 3 Amman City Tour - Jerash Tour - Amman (approx. 55km day)

After breakfast enjoy a city tour of Amman with a local guide, including a visit to the Amman Citadel (entrance included), a historical site on a hilltop in the centre of downtown Amman. With temples, churches and the Umayyad Palace, the citadel is a large palatial complex from the Umayyad period. From a small, ruined Byzantine church, dating from the fifth or sixth century, to the large Umayyad Mosque and the huge Umayyad Palace complex, which stretches over the northern part of the hill, Amman Citadel gives you spectacular views. In the afternoon travel to Jerash, a well preserved Greco-Roman city with cardo arches, theatres and Roman churches. Afterwards return back to Amman and enjoy dinner at the hotel.

Overnight: Days Inn Hotel Suites or similar, Amman, Jordan

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

# Day 4 Amman - Madaba - Nebo - Little Petra - Petra (approx. 250km day)

Today travel south to Madaba, an ancient town known for the St George Church, which has a beautiful mosaic map of the Holy Land. Continue to the biblical hill of Mount Nebo, overlooking the Jordan Valley and Dead Sea. Mount Nebo is where Moses was granted a view of the Promised Land. Next travel to Little Petra, an archaeological site just north of Petra. Here you will find the remains of a small settlement that dates back to the Neolithic period. Afterwards continue to Petra for the night.

Overnight: Petra Moon Hotel or similar, Petra, Jordan Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

### **Day 5 Petra Half Day Tour**

Inhabited since prehistoric times, this Nabatean caravan-city, situated between the Red and the Dead Sea, was an important crossroads between Arabia, Egypt and Syria-Phoenicia. Petra is half-built, half-carved into rock, and is surrounded by mountains riddled with passages and gorges. It's one of the world's most famous archaeological sites, where ancient Eastern traditions blend with Hellenistic architecture. Today enjoy a tour of the magnificent site.

Travel along the Siq, the main entrance which is a natural passage between two mountains, leading to the Treasury, the most elaborate temple in Petra. Across from the theatre and overlooking the city centre lies the Royal tombs on the eastern cliff. The lower part of Petra, where the Romans resided after 107 AD, has ruins of Nabatean Temples which are still standing.





After lunch (not included) there is an opportunity for those who are interested and able (there are many stairs) to walk up to the Monastery, which is the largest monument in the city. Afterwards everyone will be transferred back to the hotel.

Overnight: Petra Moon Hotel or similar, Petra, Jordan

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

# Day 6 Petra - Wadi Rum - Wadi Rum Jeep Tour (approx. 120km day)

After breakfast drive towards the Wadi Rum Desert, a protected desert wilderness in southern Jordan. It features dramatic sandstone mountains including the many-domed Jebel Um Ishrin, and natural arches such as Burdah Rock Bridge. Many prehistoric inscriptions and carvings line rocky caverns and steep chasms, such as Khazali Canyon. The natural watering hole of 'Lawrence's Spring' is named after British soldier Lawrence of Arabia, who allegedly washed there. On arrival enjoy a two hour jeep tour to see the gorgeous red mountains and sand dunes. Tonight you will spend the night in a desert camp, where you will enjoy dinner under the stars.

Overnight: Desert Camp experience, Private tents with private facilities

Meals included: Breakfast:Dinner

# Day 7 Wadi Rum - Aqaba - Berenice Beach - Dead Sea (approx. 390km day)

Depart this morning for Aqaba, the jewel of the Red Sea. Inhabited since 4000 B.C., it's home to the Islamic-era Aqaba Fort and the adjacent Aqaba Archaeological Museum. Its beach resorts are popular for windsurfing and other water sports. Enjoy a short tour of the city including the castle and the aquarium (entrance included) before continuing onto

Berenice Beach. Located on the Red Sea, it's an authentically styled beach with exceptional landscape design and an amazing panoramic view. Enjoy time for a swim and lunch (not included). Afterwards travel to the Dead Sea and check into the hotel.

Overnight: Ramada Resort Dead Sea or similar, Dead Sea, Jordan

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

# **Day 8 Dead Sea Free Day**

Today enjoy a free day for bathing and/or relaxing. The Dead Sea is a salt lake located more than 400m below sea level, the lowest point on dry land. Its famously hypersaline water makes floating easy, and its mineral-rich black mud is used for therapeutic and cosmetic treatments. Alternatively, you can take the opportunity to join an optional tour to visit some desert castles (not included).

Optional Activity: Desert Castles Tour: \$225 per person
Today, take the opportunity to delve deeper into the historic
structures of Jordan. The tour includes transfers, all entrance
fees and a local guide throughout the day. You will visit three
castles, the first being Kharanah, Quseir Amra (world heritage
site) and finally Azraq castle. Please note this is a full day tour.


Overnight: Ramada Resort Dead Sea or similar, Dead Sea, Jordan

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

Day 9 Dead Sea - Allenby Bridge, West Bank - Jericho - Tiberias, Israel - Nazareth (approx. 150km day)

After breakfast, you will cross the Allenby Bridge border. After the formalities, head to Jericho for a panoramic visit





including seeing the ancient sycamore tree and the Mount of Temptation. Continue to the baptismal site of Kasr el Yahud. Next travel north through the Jordan Valley into Tiberias a city on the western shore of the Sea of Galilee. Its old city holds important Jewish and Christian pilgrimage sites. Afterwards travel to Nazareth and check into the hotel.

Overnight: Golden Crown Hotel or similar, Nazareth, Israel

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

# Day 10 Nazareth - Mount of Beatitudes - Tabgha - Mount Tabor - Nazareth (approx. 50km day)

Start the day by visiting the Mount of Beatitudes and then travel to Tabgha, known as the site of the miracle of 'Multiplication of Loaves and Fish'. Visit the Church of the Primacy of St. Peter and enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee after which you can enjoy a lunch of St. Peter's Fish (not included). In the afternoon, head to Mount Tabor, to visit the Church of the Transfiguration. Return back to Nazareth and enjoy dinner this evening at the hotel.

Overnight: Golden Crown Hotel or similar, Nazareth, Israel Meals included: Breakfast;Dinner

# Day 11 Nazareth - Cana - Haifa - Jerusalem (approx. 200km day)

Today visit the Church of the Annunciation, and the house of St. Joseph. Afterwards drive to Cana to visit the Church of the First Miracle, which commemorates the transformation of water into wine at the Wedding at Cana - the first miracle attributed to Jesus in the Gospel of John. In the afternoon, continue to Haifa, a port city built in tiers extending from the Mediterranean up the north slope of Mount Carmel. Visit

the Stella Maris Monastery on Mount Carmel and enjoy the view of the Baha'i Gardens. Continue the drive on the coastal highway, and make a brief stop at the Caesarea Aqueduct, ruins located by the sea-shore. Arrive in Jerusalem for the night.

Overnight: Hotel Ritz or similar, Jerusalem, Israel

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

# Day 12 Jerusalem - Bethlehem - Ein Kerem - Jerusalem (approx. 25km day)

After breakfast, start your day by visiting the Shepherds Field in Beit Sahour. From there continue to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity and the Milk Grotto. In the afternoon, drive back to Jerusalem, through Ein Kerem, where you will visit the churches of St. John the Baptist and the Visitation.

Overnight: Hotel Ritz or similar, Jerusalem, Israel

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

# Day 13 Mount of Olives - Mount Zion (approx. 10km day)

This morning enjoy a visit of the churches on the Mount of Olives including Bethphage, Pater Noster, Dominus Flevit, the Church of All Nations, and the Garden of Gethsemane. After lunch (not included), head to Mount Zion and visit the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu, followed by the Cenacle, known as the Church of the Last Supper.

Overnight: Hotel Ritz or similar, Jerusalem, Israel

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

#### Day 14 Jerusalem City Tour, Israel - Amman, Jordan

After breakfast, head to the Western Wall (Wailing Wall) and the esplanade of the temple where the mosques of the Aqsa and Dome of the Rock are found (entrances not included).





Continue walking through the way of the Cross 'Via Dolorosa' and visit the Stations of the Cross and some churches built along the way, finishing with the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. In the afternoon travel back to Amman, Jordan via the Sheik Hussein border crossing and check into the hotel.

Overnight: Days Inn Hotel Suites or similar, Amman, Jordan

Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

#### Day 15 Amman, Jordan - New Zealand

After breakfast and check out you will transferred to the airport for your return flight back to New Zealand. Please note: if your flight departs early, breakfast will be arranged for pick up from the hotel reception the night before.

#### **TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER**

#### **Tour Guide:**

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.

#### **Tour Leader:**

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a



standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

#### Jordan and Israel:

For ideal sightseeing conditions, the best time to visit Jordan and Israel is during the spring (March - May) and autumn (September to November) months. At these times of the year the temperatures are cool enough to spend your days exploring Jordan and Israel's iconic sites.

# Jordan

A tourist visa for Jordan is a strict requirement if travelling on an New Zealand passport and is available for purchase upon arrival.

## Israel

A tourist visa for Israel is not a requirement if travelling for up to 90 days on an New Zealand Passport.

Please note: Passengers who are not New Zealand citizens must check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required. It is also important to note, some areas of employment such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations may have additional restrictions in applying for Visas. This may in turn affect the type of application required.
