# THE ITINERARY

# Day 1 Australia - Negombo (Colombo), Sri Lanka

Depart from Sydney, Melbourne, \*Brisbane or Perth for Negombo (Colombo), Sri Lanka. Fly with airlines such as Singapore Airlines, Cathay Pacific, Thai Airways or Srilankan Airlines to name a few. Upon arrival you will be transferred to your accommodation.

Please note: Some Perth customers may be required to depart in the early hours of day 1. Flight times and schedules will be indicated in your travel pack approximately 6 weeks prior to departure.

Overnight: Heritance Negombo or similar, Negombo Meals included: In-Flight

# Day 2 Negombo - Kandalama/Sigiriya (approx. 140km day)

Following breakfast, enjoy a cooking demonstration to learn about the exciting flavours and techniques used in Sri Lankan cuisine. In the afternoon depart for Kandalama. Upon arrival check into the hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure, or alternatively join an optional tour to visit the iconic Sigiriya Rock Fortress (not included).

## Optional Activity: Sigiriya Rock Fortress - \$55 AUD per person

In the afternoon visit Sigiriya Rock Fortress. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Sigiriya is the fifth century rock citadel of King Kasyapa. Step through the gigantic 'Lion Paws', set overlooking the symmetrical royal gardens, to comprehend the splendour that once dominated this rock fortress. Surrounded by ramparts and moats, the Lion Rock is coated by frescoes that relate to Gupta style paintings found in the Ajanta caves of India. Wander into the museum downstairs for an insight into how the citadel floated above citizens, and learn about the

advanced ponds and irrigation that pumped water right onto its summit through an ingenious hydraulic system.

Travel Tip: Don't forget to take a bottle of water and a face towel. Do not take pictures of the frescos, as it can be a punishable offence according to the rule of the archeological department.

# Day 3 Kandalama/Sigiriya Free Day

Today enjoy the day at leisure, or join one or both of the following optional tours:

Optional Activity: Half Day Jeep safari in Minneriya National Park - \$95 AUD per person

Experience a morning safari at Minneriya National Park. If you're up for a serious rumble in the jungle, then Minneriya is the place to go! Spread over 8800 hectares, it's a sanctuary for elephants and home to herds of deer and ample birdlife, but its spotlight remains between swaying trunks and flapping ears. Park your jeep on the bank of the reservoir and switch off its engine. Have the opportunity to see herds of elephants - one by one - roll on to the grass-covered banks, to feed on tender shoots. In fact, this is the largest elephant gathering in the world (over 300 at a time) – it's an absolute must-do for wildlife enthusiasts.

Optional Activity: Afternoon Polonnaruwa City Tour by Tuk

Tuk - \$90 AUD

Rising with the decline of Anuradhapura, the city of Polonnaruwa - medieval capital and crown jewel of King Parakramabahu I - remains superior proof of ancient culture

and heritage blended with religious beliefs. Walk among the scattered walls of this World Heritage Site, dotted with stupas, resting Buddha statues, irrigation canals and fantastically carved Hindu sculptures – while observing the relic house - Vatadage - which boasts impressive stone carvings. Look closely you will notice a subtle Hindu influence to the architecture and statues found in Polonnaruwa.

Overnight: Heritance Kandalama or similar, Kandalama Meals included: Breakfast

# Day 4 Sigiriya/Kandalama - Dambulla - Kandy (approx. 90km day)

After breakfast, travel to Dambulla and stop at the Dambulla Rock Cave Temple, which has been treasured by many kings since the first century B.C. An icon of Sri Lanka, Dambulla Rock Cave Temple features five magnificently constructed cave temples flanking the golden temple of Dambulla. Observe the exquisite cave paintings along walls that shelter 150 statues of Lord Buddha. As you enter the retreat, be sure to cast your eyes up to the gigantic Buddha statue glittering in gold, which today houses an important junction in the country's economic and cultural uplifting.

On completion of the tour leave for Kandy. On arrival, check into the hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. Alternatively, embark on an optional guided city tour (not included).

Optional Activity: Kandy City Tour & Cultural Show - \$30 AUD

Kandy was the last royal capital of Sri Lankan kings – a centre of culture, history and heritage. Experience the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic of Lord Buddha. A stroll across this small lakeside town cradled among the misty hills will take in the Kandy city centre as well as a bazaar, an arts and crafts centre,

as well as a gem and lapidary museum.

Fine tune your evening by stepping to the beat of traditional music and drumming, amplified by a cultural show enhancing the rich and vibrant culture of the Wonder of Asia, Sri Lanka. Afterwards, you will be transferred to the hotel.

Overnight: Earl's Regent, Cinnamon Citadel or similar, Kandy Meals included: Breakfast

### Day 5 Kandy - Nuwara Eliya (approx. 91km day)

After breakfast, depart for Nuwara Eliya. In the afternoon commence a sight-seeing tour of Nuwara Eliya. Sri Lanka, tea and tourism are words which cannot be separated. Take a tour to the cold & misty hills that take pride of an ultimate tea tour, covering lush green blankets of tea plantations. Or just step into a tea factory processing the prestigious brand of Ceylon Tea, to observe a rich tradition kept alive up to date. As you observe the hissing and swishing of machines, inhaling the heavenly scent arising from these facilities, make sure to end your day in style over a perfectly blended cup of pure Ceylon Tea.

In the evening, take the opportunity to join an optional fine dining dinner at the Train Carriage Restaurant (not included)

Optional Activity: Dinner at the Train Carriage Restaurant - \$75 USD (subject to availability)

Tonight your special dinner will be in the Train Carriage Restaurant. From the moment the railway master blows his whistle to welcome you aboard, you know you're in for a unique dining experience. TCK 6685, a third-class carriage of the Udapussellawa narrow-gauge railway line that used to transport tea but closed down in 1950, has been converted to a fine-dining restaurant. Its former passengers would marvel at today's menu, with its range of top-quality ingredients from

around the world – smoked salmon from Norway, beef and lamb from Australia, and duck from the US. And, of course, there's an international wine list to match.

Overnight: Heritance Tea Factory, Araliya Green Hills Hotel or similar, Nuwara Eliya Meals included: Breakfast

# Day 6 Nuwara Eliya - Weligama (approx. 235km)

After breakfast, travel to Weligama approx. 6 hours). Upon arrival, check into the hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure relaxing by the beach.

Overnight: Marriott Weligama, Weligama Meals included: Breakfast

# Day 7 Weligama - Galle Fort Tour - Weligama (approx. 70km)

After breakfast at the hotel, proceed to Galle Dutch Fort and embark on a guided city tour.

Galle, the epic Southern capital, is the intersection where classic Dutch architecture meets a tropical setting creating a vivid atmosphere in beauty. Walk the Dutch-haunted streets listening to the creaks of wooden saloon doors and observe how European architecture mingles with South Asian traditions today flooding cultural enthusiasts on a global scale. Its original ramparts and bastions preserved up to date showcase evidences of a heritage preserved for more than 3 1/2 centuries. Walk clockwise within the fort to observe the 'old gate' carrying the British coat of arms. Flanking the old gate is the Zwart bastion - the oldest of all - and the lighthouse standing 18 feet in its glory next to the Point Utrecht Bastion. This Dutch bliss is painted with streets that spread in a rectangular grid pattern pierced with houses carrying Dutch

colonial style verandas.

Hop into the Dutch Hospital Shopping Complex to be mesmerised by an array of souvenir selections. However, its hallmark stands a reality where the Dutch fort remains a working community with its usual buzz of administrative offices, court complex, commercial buildings, churches and Southern folks frequenting its streets bracing the air of the Elysium of architecture, Galle! Upon completion, return to the hotel and spend the rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Marriott Weligama, Weligama Meals included: Breakfast

### **Day 8 Weligama Free Day**

After breakfast at the hotel, spend the day at leisure relaxing at the hotel & enjoy the beach.

### **TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER**

### **Tour Guide:**

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on history, art, architecture and culture of the city/ village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.

## **Tour Leader:**

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however, they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/ attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

#### CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

### Sri Lanka:

Sri Lanka is a year-round destination with two monsoon seasons so there is a lot of confusion around when is the best time to visit. The weather doesn't run like clockwork here! However, there will rarely be weather so dramatic that it will stand in the way of a brilliant holiday with plenty of warm weather and sunshine. The temperature is constant at around 27°C on the coast, both the air and the water!

# Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points:

At TripADeal we do not arrange seat selection. It is important to highlight that some Airlines do not allow pre-selected seats. ### **Yellow Fever:**

A valid international certificate of vaccination against Yellow Fever is required in many countries. You may need to present this on arrival at the airport or border crossing. Some countries will refuse entry if you are unable to present your certificate. It's also quite common for your home country to request a Yellow Fever certificate on your arrival back home.

It is your responsibility to check with your doctor well in advance of leaving home about the Yellow Fever requirements for the countries you'll be visiting.

# **Gratuities / Tipping:**

### Land

Gratuities (tips) are not included in the tour price for services of the tour leader (when available) and driver throughout the tour. The recommended tip is 1000 Rupees per person per day. This covers the guide/leader and the driver, which will be collected whilst on tour.

Tipping for all services provided on tour is always a matter of personal discretion, however, please be aware that tipping is considered by many locals to be a part of their normal remuneration and they may approach

you for payment and there is no need to be intimidated by the request.

### Sightseeing:

### Sri Lanka

A Tourist Visa for Sri Lanka is a strict requirement if travelling on an Australian Passport. You will be able to start your Visa application process once you receive your final travel documentation approximately 6 weeks prior to departure.

TripADeal offers a fast, secure and easy service to obtain a Visa for this country. This E-visa can take approximately 4 business days to complete.

Please note: Passengers who are not Australian citizens must check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required. It is also important to note, some areas of employment such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations may have additional restrictions in applying for Visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.
