Not far from Notre Dame, you will see the Palace of the Conciergerie, formerly a prison but presently used for practising law. The prison housed as many as 1200 prisoners in its heyday, including the famous Marie Antoinette (Queen of France).

Continue onwards to the Latin Quarter, the literary and intellectual area and home to the former University of Sorbonne. Afterwards, take some time to admire the impressive Luxembourg Garden and Saint Germain des Pres (entrances not included). Continue through Les Halles shopping district (formerly a fresh food market in the 19th century) until you reach the cultural centre of 'George Pompidou', built in 1977 by the famous architect Renzo Piano as the Museum of Contemporary Art. To finish your tour on a high, see the centrepiece of Paris' cityscape, the Eiffel Tower. Enjoy the remainder of today at leisure.

#### **Tour Leader:**

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can
