## THE ITINERARY

### Day 1 Australia - Baku, Azerbaijan

Today depart Sydney, Melbourne, \*Brisbane, Adelaide or Perth for Baku, Azerbaijan. Fly with award-winning Qatar Airways (subject to availability).

*Please note: Due to flight scheduling and availability, some customers may be required to depart on Day 2, to arrive on Day 2. Flight times will be indicated on your final documentation, which you will receive 4-6 weeks prior to departure.*

Meals included: In-Flight

### Day 2 Welcome to Baku

Upon arrival at the airport, you will be greeted and transferred to your hotel in Baku.

Overnight: Renaissance Palace Hotel, Baku or similar

Meals included: None

### Day 3 Baku City Tour

After breakfast, embark on a Baku city tour with your local guide. Enjoy a panoramic view of Baku city and bay from Highland Park. See Martyrs Alley, a cemetery and memorial in Baku, and a marvellous view of Flame Towers, a famous trio of skyscrapers in the city. Later, visit the Old City - the most historical part of Baku. Walk through the narrow cobbled stone streets, visit the fortification tower, Caravanserai complexes, the UNESCO listed Maiden Tower, and Shirvanshahs Palace - one of the pearls of Azerbaijan's architecture (entrances included). The tour then continues to Nizami Street - a large pedestrian shopping hub in downtown Baku. This afternoon, enjoy a traditional lunch at a local restaurant. Next, visit the National History Museum of

Azerbaijan (entrance included). Weather permitting, you will also have the opportunity to join a boat tour of the Caspian Sea which is lined with a beautiful seaside boulevard.

Overnight: Renaissance Palace Hotel, Baku or similar

Meals included: Breakfast;Lunch

### Day 4 Baku - Absheron Peninsula (approx. 15km day)

Today, enjoy a sightseeing tour of the Absheron Peninsula. See the Ateshgah, the Fire Worshippers Temple, Qala Archaeological and Ethnographic Museum Complex (entrances included). Also see the Ramana Tower, which dates back to the 12th century (entrance not included). Continue to the otherworldly Yanar Dag (Fire Mountain), where a natural gas fire blazes continuously, followed by the Oil Derrick Forrest and see the Heydar Aliyev Centre - designed by the late Iraqi-British architect Zaha Hadid. In the late afternoon return to Baku.

Overnight: Renaissance Palace Hotel, Baku or similar

Meals included: Breakfast

### Day 5 Baku - Gobustan (approx. 90km day)

Today visit the Gobustan National Park, a UNESCO world heritage site. On the way, stop to view remarkable mud volcanoes, formed by the eruption of earth, water and gas from below the surface. On arrival at the Gobustan National Park, take some time to admire the ancient rock carvings, which depict primitive people, animals, battle-pieces, ritual dances and much more. The park has more than 6000 rock

carvings near the Caspian Sea Side, which date back to anywhere from 5,000 to 20,000 years ago. On the way back to Baku, visit the Bibi-Heybat Mosque - a modern re-creation of a famous mosque which was destroyed under Stalin's orders in 1934. Afterwards, visit the Azerbaijan Carpet Museum which holds an array of traditional Azerbaijani carpets and rugs using various weaving techniques and materials.

**Overnight: Renaissance Palace Hotel, Baku or similar**

**Meals included:** Breakfast

### Day 6 Baku - Sheki (approx. 304km day)

Today, head to the ancient city of Gabala. En-route visit the 15th century Diri Baba Mausoleum in Maraza. Continue to Juma Mosque and the Mausoleum of Yeddi Gumbez in Shamakhi city. Next, drive through Girdimanchay River canyon to the village of Lahij, a popular destination on the historic silk road. Here, you will see the workshops of blacksmiths, potteries, carpet weaving shops and more as you walk through the cobbled streets. The tour then continues to Sheki, in the southern area of the Greater Caucasus mountain range. On the way, stop at the Chotari Albanian Church and Udi house in Nij village. The village is home to a population of people who are direct descendants of the ancient Caucasian Albanians, and they are known as the Udi people. See the Chotari Albanian-Udi church in Nij settlement which acted as a reservoir for hazelnuts in Soviet era. Upon arrival in Sheki, take the remainder of the day at leisure.

**Overnight: Marxal Resort Hotel, Sheki or similar**

**Meals included:** Breakfast

### Day 7 Sheki City Tour

This morning, visit a local Eastern style bazaar before a visit to the Kish village and first church of Caucasus. Then continue to Old Sheki where you will explore the Palace of Shaki Khans, the Historical Museum, and the Round Temple (entrance not included). Afterwards, you will have the chance to join an arts and crafts workshop, creating traditional Shebaka stained glass windows. You'll also be able to see the creation process of the 'takalduz' (traditional instrument). Finish the day with a quick visit to the Sheki Caravanserai, a historical moment.

**Overnight: Marxal Resort Hotel, Sheki or similar**

**Meals included:** Breakfast

### Day 8 Sheki, Azerbaijan - Tbilisi, Georgia (approx. 270km day)

Following breakfast, head to Lagodekhi, the border passage to Tbilisi, Georgia. Along the way, stop at the village of Bodbe and see the monastery complex of St. George and the grave of St. Nino, the individuals who brought Christianity to Georgia. Afterwards, arrive in Sighnaghi and wander through the ancient town, perched atop a ridge overlooking the Alazani Valley. In the late afternoon arrive in Tbilisi, the capital city of Georgia.

**Optional Activity: Georgian wine tasting at Javakhishvili Winery - \$30 per person**

**Overnight: City Avenue Hotel, Tbilisi or similar**

**Meals included:** Breakfast

### Day 9 Tbilisi - Mtskheta (approx. 25km day)

After breakfast, embark on a tour of Mtskheta, a UNESCO listed site which was the ancient capital of Georgia. Visit the Svetitskhoveli Cathedral (1010-1029), which is the burial

place of many Georgian kings and historical relics. Stop for lunch at the famous Salobio Restaurant and enjoy some traditional Georgian cuisine. After lunch, take in the sights of Tbilisi on a guided tour. Visit the old town and historic centre of Tbilisi, located at the foot of Mount Mtatsminda. Almost all buildings in the Old Town are historic sites; this part of the city buzzes with energy around the clock. Here artists often exhibit paintings and artisans sell their wares. You can admire the Tbilisi architecture, which is characterised by narrow streets, galleries and carved wooden balconies. During the tour you will also see the Mechetian Church, Narikala Fortress, Sioni Cathedral, Anchiskhati Basilica of St Mary, and 'Sameba' Holy Trinity Cathedral, the main Cathedral of The Georgian Orthodox Church.

**Overnight: City Avenue Hotel, Tbilisi or similar**

**Meals included:** Breakfast;Lunch

### Day 10 Tbilisi - Akhaltsikhe (approx. 210km day)

Today, the tour continues for Vardzia. Along the way stop at Borjomi, a town famous for its fresh mineral water which you can drink from the spring. Afterwards, arrive in Vardzia, a cave monastery complex where around 600 buildings including churches, chapels, pantries, baths, libraries are carved into the mountain face. You will see the remains of preserved secret passages and ancient plumbing and irrigation systems. The site of Vardzia represents the Golden Age, and it is said that thousands of monks have once lived there. In the evening, check in to your hotel in Akhaltsikhe.

**Overnight: Gino Rabath Hotel, Akhaltsikhe or similar**

**Meals included:** Breakfast

### Day 11 Akhaltsikhe - Gori - Tbilisi (approx. 215km day)

Following breakfast, visit the recently reconstructed Akhaltsikhe Fortress. Inside the complex is a mosque, catholic church and monastery of the Benedictine Sisters, a synagogue, and an Armenian church. Afterwards continue to the city of Gori, built by King David the Builder in 1089-1125. Gori is also the birthplace of Joseph Stalin, so naturally a stop in Gori isn't complete without a visit to the Stalin Museum (entrance included). Return to Tbilisi and enjoy the remainder of the day at your own leisure.

**Overnight: City Avenue Hotel, Tbilisi or similar**

**Meals included:** Breakfast

### Day 12 Tbilisi - Ananuri - Gudauri - Kazbegi - Tbilisi (approx. 300km day)

This morning, depart to Stepantsminda (Kazbegi). On the way, admire the picturesque Ananuri fortress located above Aragvi River. You will also witness the amazing beauty of Zhinvali reservoir. Once you reach Kazbegi, travel by 4x4 vehicles to the Holy Gergeti or Trinity Church, located 2170m above sea level. Weather permitting, you will be treated to stunning views of Mount Kazbeg (5147m), a dormant stratovolcano and one of the highest peaks in Georgia.

**Optional Activity: Georgian farewell dinner and folklore show at a local restaurant - \$45 per person**

**Overnight: City Avenue Hotel, Tbilisi or similar**

**Meals included:** Breakfast

### Day 13 Tbilisi - Australia

Today at the appropriate time be transferred to the airport for your return flight back to Australia. Please note: Due to limited flight scheduling some customers may experience a layover of up to 6 1/2 hours on this outbound flight. Lounge

### TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

#### Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.

#### Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

*Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.*

## CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

### Baku, Azerbaijan:

The climate is temperate with a

marine influence therefore a constant marine breeze. There is a great range in temperatures; the winters are cold and even somewhat rigorous in the mountains, summers are hot and the other seasons are quite marked too.

## Tbilisi, Georgia:

- It has a humid subtropical with considerable continental influences. The city experiences very warm summers and moderately cold winters. Because the city is bounded on most sides by mountain ranges, the close proximity to large bodies of water (Black and Caspian Seas) and the fact that the Greater Caucasus Mountains Range (further to the north) blocks the intrusion of cold air masses from Russia, Tbilisi has a relatively mild micro climate compared to other cities that possess a similar climate along the same latitudes.

- The average annual temperature in Tbilisi is 13.3°C. In September the average temperature will be between 26°C to 15°C, October will be 20°C to 10°C and November 13 °C to 5°C.

## FLIGHTS

### Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points:

At TripADeal we do not arrange seat selection. It is important to highlight that some Airlines do not allow pre-selected seats. We strongly suggest you contact the Airline directly with seating allocation requirements and or arrive at the airport earlier to arrange your seating. While we do not add frequent flyer member details to bookings, you can do this directly with the Airline once you have your flight information.

### Passport Validity:

## VISAS

### Georgia:

Australian passport holders can visit Georgia without a visa for periods of up to 12 months.

### Azerbaijan:

A tourist visa is required for Azerbaijan if travelling on an Australian passport. Electronic visas (e-visa) are for single entry, 30 day stays are available online through Azerbaijan's State Agency for Public Service and Social Innovations here: <https://evisa.gov.az/en#>. Allow at least three business days for online

applications to be processed and ensure your passport is valid for at least three months from the expiry date of the e-visa.

If your passport contains visas/stamps from the disputed territory of Nagorno-Karabakh, you'll likely encounter difficulties at Azerbaijan border control points and could be refused entry into Azerbaijan.

**Important:** Please start arranging your visa at least 3 weeks prior to departure to account for any delays due to consulate operating hours.

*Please note: Passengers who are not Australian citizens must check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required. It is also important to note, some areas of employment such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations may have additional restrictions in applying for Visas. This may in turn affect the type of application required.*

- Changes within 30 days of departure \$350.00 person + any additional charges applied by the airline/cruise company/accommodation/other travel provider.
- Changes within 14 days of departure \$500.00 per person + any additional charges applied by the airline/cruise company/accommodation/other travel provider.

## Name Changes Due To Passenger Error

- If the incorrect name has been advised to TripADeal, charges of \$150.00 per person + any additional charges applied by the airline/cruise company/accommodation/other travel provider.
