30 Day Standard Package

Day 1 New Zealand - Barcelona, Spain

Today, depart from Auckland or *Christchurch for Barcelona, Spain! Fly with full service airlines such as Emirates, Etihad Airways, Lufthansa, Finnair or Swiss Airlines to name a few (subject to availability).

Please note: due to flight scheduling and availability, some departures may occur on day 2 to arrive day 2. Flight times will be indicated on your final documentation which you will receive prior to departure.

Day 2 Welcome to Barcelona, Spain

Welcome to Barcelona! Be met on arrival and transferred to your hotel for the night.

Overnight: Rafaelhoteles Badalona or similar, Barcelona

Meals included: None

Day 3 Barcelona Free Day

Today is free to spend at leisure in this bustling city.

Defined by quirky art and architecture, imaginative food and vibrant street life; Barcelona is the cosmopolitan capital of Spain's Catalonia region. It has medieval roots, seen in the maze like Gothic Quarter, juxtaposed with a modernist personality, as represented by architect Antoni Gaudi's fantastical Sagrada Familia church (entrance not included). The city's restaurant scene, anchored by the central Boqueria market, ranges from fine dining to tiny tapas bars. You won't be short of things to uncover in this fascinating city.

Overnight: Rafaelhoteles Badalona or similar, Barcelona

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 4 Barcelona, Spain - Arles, France (approx. 400km day)

Today enjoy a scenic drive through Costa Brava towards Arles - a French city in the Provence region, encircled by an environment of exceptional beauty on the banks of the Rhône river. Upon arrival, enjoy time at leisure in this UNESCO listed city, famous for its historical buildings and links to artists such as Van Gough (many of his paintings were inspired by the city).

Overnight: Hotel Styles Palais de Congres or similar, Arles

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 5 Arles - Cannes (approx. 220km day)

Following breakfast, the journey continues to the French Riviera city of Cannes, synonymous with the annual Cannes Film Festival. This resort town is home to a level of wealth and glamour that cannot fail to impress. Upon arrival, explore the town at leisure. If you are looking for a place to enjoy dinner (not included) choose one of the many waterfront restaurants, and feel like a local as you stroll through the paved streets of town.

Overnight: Hotel Ibis Mandelieu or similar, Cannes

Day 6 Cannes - Nice - Monaco - Cannes (approx. 120km day)

Home to the annual Monaco Grand Prix, not to mention one of the most impressive harbours (purely for the size of the yachts), Monaco is stepping into another world! In the late afternoon return to your hotel in Cannes.

Day 7 Cannes - Paris (TGV High Speed Train Journey)

Bid Cannes farewell after breakfast and head north today. Board the TGV (High Speed Train) and relax as you travel through Aix-en-Provence, Avignon, and Lyon en route to magical Paris (approx. five-hour journey). Day 10 London City Tour

After breakfast experience a half day guided tour of London. See Buckingham Palace - residence of the Royal family, Oxford Street, Piccadilly Circus, Trafalgar Square, the Houses of Parliament, and the Tower of London, where the crown jewels have been kept since the 14th century (entrances not included). Afterwards, spend the afternoon continuing to explore this bustling city.

Overnight: Ibis Earl Court or similar, London

Day 11 London, England - Amsterdam, Netherlands (Eurostar Train Journey)

This morning transfer to St. Pancras International Station to take the Eurostar train to Amsterdam (approx. a 4.5-hour journey). Upon arrival to Amsterdam Station, transfer the hotel for check-in. Take a walking tour of Amsterdam with your tour leader to see what this incredible city has to offer. For centuries, the world's largest commercial port has been known as the "Venice of the North" because of the many canals and over 600 bridges that cross it. See the famous Dam Square, the Benginhof, the flower Market on the Singel, and The Tower of Montelbaan (entrances not included).

Overnight: Best Western Amedia Airport or similar, Amsterdam

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 12 Amsterdam, Netherlands - Hamburg, Germany (approx. 470km day)

After breakfast depart for Hamburg, a major port city in Northern Germany, connected to the North Sea by the Elbe River. It's criss-crossed by hundreds of canals, and also contains large areas of scenic parkland. Near its core, Inner Alster lake is dotted with boats and fringed by cafes. Upon arrival, check into the hotel and spend the remainder of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Leonardo Hotel City Nord or similar, Hamburg

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 13 Hamburg - Berlin (approx. 290km day)

Today continue your journey to Berlin, the capital of Germany. On arrival, the remainder of the day is yours to spend at leisure soaking in the culture of the city. With the many cafés, clubs, bars, street art, and numerous museums, palaces, and other sites of historic interest, Berlin has plenty to capture your attention.

Overnight: Hotel Ibis Styles Berlin Treptow or similar, Berlin

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 14 Berlin Walking Tour

After breakfast enjoy a walking tour with your tour leader to see the Berlin Wall Memorial in Bernauer Strasse, the Checkpoint Charlie, and the Mauermuseum (entrances not included). Afterwards enjoy free time to further explore this

amazing city.

Overnight: Hotel Ibis Styles Berlin Treptow or similar, Berlin

Day 15 Berlin - Dresden, Germany - Prague, Czech Republic (approx. 350km day)

This morning, say goodbye to Berlin and travel towards Prague, Czech Republic. Along the way, stop in Dresden, known as 'the Jewel Box of Germany' thanks to its Baroque and Rococo city centre. In the late afternoon arrive at Prague and check into the hotel.

Overnight: Clarion Congress Hotel or similar, Prague

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 16 Prague City Tour

After breakfast enjoy a half day guided tour with your local tour guide through Prague, often called the 'City of the Hundred Spires'. See the most significant places and sights of the city, including Wenceslas Square, the National Theatre, the Lesser Town and Hradcany with Prague Castle, Charles Bridge, the former Jewish district and the Astronomical Clock in the Old Town Square. The afternoon is free to enjoy at leisure.

Overnight: Clarion Congress Hotel or similar, Prague

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 17 Prague - Brno, Czech Republic - Krakow, Poland (approx. 535km day)

Today depart Prague and relax while enjoying a scenic drive to Krakow. On the way stop at Brno, a city in the Czech Republic known for its modernist buildings. It is a lively place of innovation and creativity. Continue on to Krakow and check

into the hotel for the evening.

Overnight: Q Hotel Plus Krakow or similar, Krakow

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 18 Krakow - Auschwitz (approx. 130km day)

After breakfast at the hotel, travel to Auschwitz for a guided tour of the largest Nazi concentration camp, built and operated by the Third Reich, annexed by Nazi Germany during World War II.

Afterwards return to Krakow and enjoy time at leisure. The city's medieval old town is one of the finest in Europe. Check out the youthful restaurants, bars and cultural hangouts. While in the city, be sure to take a walk through the historic Jewish Quarter of Kazimierz, followed by a stroll along Wisla River, or choose to discover some of the main sites such as Krakow's Main Square, St Mary's Basilica or St Florian's Gate (entrances not included).

Overnight: Q Hotel Plus Krakow, or similar Krakow

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 19 Krakow, Poland - Budapest, Hungary (approx. 400km day)

Today depart for Budapest, one of central Europe's most delightful cities. Thanks to its scenic riverside location and spectacular architecture, it is widely known as the 'Paris of the East'. Upon arrival, check into the house and enjoy the afternoon at leisure to discover the city.

Overnight: Ibis Styles Budapest Centre or similar, Budapest

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 20 Budapest Walking Tour

After breakfast, explore Hungary's capital on a walking tour with your tour leader. See the 19th-century Chain Bridge that connects its hilly Buda district with flat Pest and Trinity Square which is home to the 13th-century Matthias Church and the turrets of the Fishermen's Bastion, which offer sweeping views. Continue exploring this remarkable city at your own pace this afternoon.

Day 21 Budapest - Bratislava, Slovakia - Vienna, Austria (approx. 280km day)

This morning depart for 'the Imperial City' of Vienna. On the way stop at Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia where the 18th-century old town is known for its lively bars and cafes. Perched atop a hill, Bratislava Castle overlooks the old town and the Danube River. Enjoy some free time this beautiful city before continuing on to Vienna for a late afternoon arrival.

Overnight: Arcotel Hotel Wimberger or similar, Vienna

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 22 Vienna Walking Tour

Today, enjoy a walking tour with your tour leader. Vienna, Austria's capital, lies in the country's east on the Danube River. Its artistic and intellectual legacy was shaped by residents including Mozart, Beethoven and Sigmund Freud. The city is also known for its Imperial Palaces, including Schönbrunn, the Habsburgs' summer residence. In the Museumsquartier district, historic and contemporary buildings display works by Egon Schiele, Gustav Klimt and other artists.

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 23 Vienna - Graz (approx. 200km day)

Today after breakfast travel to Graz, which blends Renaissance and baroque architecture. Upon arrival, enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure in this stunning Austrian city.

Overnight: Hotel Roomz Graz or similar, Graz

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 24 Graz, Austria - Ljubljana, Slovenia (approx. 200km day)

Today depart to the Slovenian capital of Ljubljana, one of Europe's greenest and most liveable capitals. Upon arrival explore the city at leisure. From the picturesque central open-air market to the Three Bridges, the Baroque Town Hall, Ljubljanica River and Robba's Fountain, there are plenty of sights to be uncovered (entrances not included).

Overnight: Radisson Blue Plaza Hotel or similar, Ljubljana

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 25 Ljubljana, Slovenia - Venice, Italy City Tour (approx. 240km day)

This morning travel to the grand Italian city of Venice. Upon arrival you will explore Venice on a half day guided tour. Begin with a waterbus ride to San Marco Island. Once on the island you'll see some of Venice's best-known locations, beginning in the Piazza with the Basilica di San Marco, a stunning piece of Byzantine architecture. See the famous Bridge of Sighs, which appears on many a postcard or picture of Venice and connects

the old prison to the interrogation rooms in the Doge's Palace. Afterwards feel free to walk the alleyways and canals of this beautiful floating city.

Overnight: Sport Hotel All'Ancora or similar, Mestre (Venice Area)

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 26 Venice - Florence, Italy (approx. 270km day)

Enjoy breakfast this morning before setting out for Florence. In the heart of Tuscany, Florence (known as Firenze to the locals) was the centre of medieval European trade and finance and is considered the birthplace of the Renaissance. Enjoy an overview of the city from Piazzale Michelangelo, which boasts glorious vistas over the red roofs, Arno River and ancient city walls out towards the Tuscan countryside. From here enjoy a walk around Florence's many highlights, including the Ponte Vecchio over the Arno, the Piazza del Duomo and Campanile Tower.

Overnight: Art Hotel Museo, Prato (Florence Area)

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 27 Florence - Rome City Tour (approx. 270km day)

Today head south through the jaw-dropping Tuscan countryside to Rome. On arrival enjoy a half day guided tour with a local guide to experience some of the richest historical sites in the world. See Piazza Venezia, the Campidoglio, centre of political life; Av. Del Fora Imperiale; the former centre of political, commercial and legal life; the Colosseum (outside) arena of gladiators and the Arch of Constantine; a monument dedicated to Emperor Constantine in 315 by the Senate and the people of the Ancient Rome (entrances not included).

You can also see the Palatino, where former emperors and influential people once lived, the exterior of the vast Circus Maximus, the main site in the city where chariot-racing events were held (entrances included).

Today after breakfast enjoy the last full day of the tour free at leisure.

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Europe:

Spring in Europe is in March, April and May is a great season to discover Europe. Temperatures range from lows of 5°C to highs of 19°C. Summer is from June to August and is when the region is at its peak travel time with many Europeans and Brits heading to the coastlines of France, Spain, Greece, Italy and Turkey to soak up some vitamin D.
