THE ITINERARY

Day 1 Airlie Beach, Whitsunday Coast, QLD

Today, make your own way to Airlie Beach for an early afternoon check-in to the Marina Shores Hotel. Stay in a gorgeous Garden View Spa Apartment. The hotel is only a ten minute walk to the Coral Sea Marina, and 2kms from Airlie Lagoon, as well as the myriad of shops and restaurants in the town centre. Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Day 3 Sailing Whitsunday Islands

Check out this morning and store your luggage at the hotel. Enjoy some time at leisure before heading to Coral Sea Marina to join the Whitsunday sailing boat 'The Adventurer'.

Depart the Coral Sea Marina Resort (formerly the Abell Point Marina) at approx. 3.00pm.

Get ready for an unforgettable sailing experience. Enjoy the view as 'The Adventurer' weaves her way around the islands, taking time to stop at top destinations including Whitehaven Beach, Hill Inlet Lookout, and the fringing reefs of the Great

Barrier Reef Marine Park. In between stops you can enjoy relaxing on the wide decks, taking the time to soak in the beauty of the tropical oasis that is the Whitsundays. Your crew will take care of everything you'll need during your trip, including preparing your delicious meals and keeping you informed, relaxed and entertained.

The first afternoon on board will typically provide you with a relaxing sail across to the islands to unwind and enjoy the sunset with drink and nibbles, after which the catamaran will be anchored for the night.

Day 4 Sailing Whitsunday Islands

Wake up to a sensational view and enjoy a delicious breakfast onboard, followed by for a guided walk through national parkland to Hill Inlet Lookout. Take in a stunning vista of the 7km long stretch of Whitehaven Beach, before heading to the beach to dip yourself in the crystal turquoise waters and sink your toes in the pure silica sands.

Back on board enjoy morning tea before heading north along the western side of Hook Island. Find anchorage in another secluded bay and enjoy lunch. Then, it's time for a snorkel. Meet the underwater life, try to find Nemo, and maybe even bump into a turtle if you're lucky.

Enjoy sunset refreshments and reflect on another stunning day as the boat heads to a calm location to anchor overnight.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

Airlie Beach and The Whitsunday

- Airlie Beach enjoys a subtropical climate that provides fine, mild weather year round. The surrounding islands experience a hot and humid wet

season from November through to May however Airlie Beach remains at a relatively steady 32 degrees Celsius with less humidity during these summer months.

- Winter in Airlie Beach falls between June to October and although the climate does get cooler, temperatures are still quite warm compared to the rest of Australia. The temperature drops to about 16 degrees Celsius during this time with a maximum of 27 degrees Celsius however most days the temperature is a mild 23 degrees Celsius allowing you to enjoy pleasant weather year round.

- Much of Airlie Beach's wonderful weather and comfortable climate can be attributed to its stunning location on the Queensland coast off the Great Barrier Reef. Facing north, Airlie Beach benefits from plenty of sunshine and cooling sea breezes to provide the perfect balance for your Tropical North Queensland holiday.
