Cruise to Tahiti and hike through the verdant jungle at Fautaua Valley – don't miss the dramatic waterfall that cascades about 300 metres down into a natural pool.

Tahiti / French Polynesia

- April brings about the end of the wet season which means humidity is substantially lower than previous months. Expect temperatures of 25°C - 30°C

- October brings about the end of the dry season. Daily temperatures will range from

the high 20's to low 30's.

Hawaii

- April: Daytime temperatures in Hawaii are comfortably warm, averaging between 25°C - 30°C, while evenings are slightly cooler around 15°C.
- October: October is the last really warm month in Hawaii, however the rains will just be starting to pick up as the wet season approaches. Expect average temperatures of 29°C.
