THE ITINERARY

Day 1 Sydney - Embark on Overnight Soren Larsen Tall Ship Experience

Welcome to Sydney Harbour. This afternoon is all about just that - the Harbour, its sapphire waters and scenic views, and enjoying the cool sea breeze in your hair while you sail.

Arrive at any time today and meet at Campbell Cove in the Rocks in the early evening, approximately 5:15pm. We'll depart Campbell's Cove near Circular Quay, on the magnificent Soren Larsen tall ship, your home for the evening and tomorrow morning.

Built in 1949, the vessel was one of the last traditional, cargo-carrying sailing ships made for Baltic Trade and since then has participated in many films and TV shows such as Shackleton, as well as the lead vessel in the eight-month First Fleet re-enactment from the UK to Sydney.

Your evening will start with an opportunity to climb the mast, with a safety harness of course, to get an extra special view of the harbour. This activity is included in the price for our guests but is of course optional.

A canape dinner will follow with included beer, wine and soft drinks. If the wind is in our favour, you can help hoist the sails to glide to our overnight mooring point or simply watch the crew do their thing.

Enjoy a nightcap watching the spectacular view and lights of the city twinkle around the iconic Sydney Harbour Bridge and Opera House. Retire below deck to your twin-share bunks.

Day 2 Sydney Harbour - Bondi

Rise early to the sounds of the city coming alive for another day and enjoy a hearty cooked breakfast. Weather dependent, you may like to go for a swim to freshen up before our walking tour of Goat Island.

The island in Port Jackson, also known as Me-mel by the local Cadigal people, is an island steeped in history and tales of convicts and controversy.

Return to Campbell's Cove by approximately 10:30am, where you'll then have the day to explore Sydney and check-in to your accommodation for the next two nights.

- Soren Larsen achieved international fame as a star of the BBC's classic series 'The Onedin Line'. Other film work includes 'French Lieutenant's Woman' and 'Shackleton', which took her to the Arctic to play the role of the Endurance in the ice pack. During filming, she became the first wooden sailing ship to reach Arctic Greenland in seventy years.

- Your twin bunk cabin on the boat is small and basic. Without windows or portholes, it is not recommended for those with claustrophobia. There are toilet facilities on board but we recommend saving your showering until you check in to your hotel the next day. To get to the toilets and cabins located below deck guests must use stairs, which are more akin to a ladder than a staircase. This package is therefore not recommended for people with restricted mobility. Please note that power is only available for charging phones and cameras when the generator is running during the evening cruise.
